Dry period breast ointment (DC)

## **Drug category:**

Intramammary antibiotics.

# **Composition:**

Each 4.5 g (5 ml) intra-breast syringe contains:

Penethamate hydriodide	100 mg
Framycetin sulphate	100mg
Benethamine penicillin	280 mg

# **Target species:**

Cattle (dairy cows in the dry season).

#### The mechanism of action:

Penicillin and Penethamate are beta-lactam antibiotics that disrupt the synthesis of the bacterial cell wall by inhibiting the trans-peptidation reaction required to form a strong cell wall, destroying the integrity of the bacterial cell wall and causing the bacterium to disintegrate.

Framycetin is a bactericidal aminoglycoside antibiotic that kills bacteria by disrupting bacterial ribosome function, bacterial protein secretion, and cell membrane permeability.

# **Amount and method of consumption:**

Before use, milk the cow for the last time, and after cleaning and disinfecting the tit, use a syringe for each Cartier, and after injecting into the breast, gently massage the Cartier to spread antibiotics.

#### Withdrawal time:

Meat and carcass: 10 days.
Milk: Treatment 35 days before delivery: up to 36 hours after delivery.
Treatment less than 35 days left to delivery: up to 37 days after treatment.

## **Storage Condition:**

Store below 25 ° C.
